Sightseeing bus city-tour

During the tour you will see the most outstanding Moscow sites. Square of three stations - railway Moscow gate, all the Stalin skyscrapers, Lubyanka Square and the building of the KGB, the Kremlin from all sides, Marshy Square, the Cathedral of Christ the Savior, Novodevichy Convent, Sparrow hills, Mosfilm, Poklonnaya hill, the Arc de Triomphe, Business center "Moscow City", Kutuzovsky Prospect, the White House - the Russian government building in Moscow, Tverskaya street, and a monument to the founder of Moscow -Yuriyu Dolgoruky, Manezh Square, the Bolshoi Theatre.

Lunch (own arrangement)

Walking tour. Red Square, St Basil's Cathedral, Kremlin (Architectural ensemble and cathedrals visiting is included) and the Alexander Garden

Our route will go through the heart of the Russian capital in the Red Square, Revolution Square, and the Alexander Garden. Attractions: Eternal Flame and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier with the change of the guard of honor, the Walk of Heroes and Cities of Military Glory, Romanovsky obelisk monument to Patriarch Hermogenes, a monument to Alexander I, monument to Marshal Georgy Zhukov, Manezh Square, the Resurrection Gate, GUM and the Kazan Cathedral, the Spasskaya Tower, St. Basil's Cathedral and Vasilevsky descent. Just as the White House in Washington, the Kremlin in Moscow is the official residence of the President of the Russian Federation. If you look at the Kremlin's plan, you will see that it is an irregular triangle with the area of 27.5 hectares. To the south of the Kremlin there is the Moscow River, to the northwest there is Alexander Gardens, and to the east there is Red Square.

The present red walls and towers of the Kremlin were built in 1485-1516. At the top the wall is decorated with the merlons in the form of a swallow's tail. On the outer side the wall is smooth and the inner side of the wall is framed with arched recesses for reinforcement and facilitating the construction. There are five palaces and four cathedrals inside the Kremlin.

Kolomenskoye Park walking tour

Kolomenskoye, a residence of Moscow Grand Princes and Russian Tsars, was first mentioned in the XIV century. Its unique architectural complex is of great art and historical value. It includes the Tsar's Courtyard complex (notably, a UNESCO site – the unique tent-roof XVI century Church of the Ascension), an open-air Museum of Wooden Architecture, and age-old gardens and parks, all the landmarks dating back from XIV to XIX c. We invite you to visit Wooden Palace of the Tsar Alexey Mikhailovich exposition which displays elements of the XVII century culture and every-day life of the Russian tsars.

Tsaritsyno walking tour

The museum-reserve Tsaritsyno is located in the south of Moscow and includes an architectural complex of the late 18th century, Greenhouses, Historical Landscaped Park with ponds and new park zones with Light dynamic fountain. The territory covers 405 hectares. The palace complex created as a suburb residence of the Empress Catherine II. It was designed and built by the architect Vasily Bazhenov. Later the new Grand Palace by Matvey Kazakov became the center of composition.

Downtown walking tour + Metro

Take a walk along the famous Arbat, where you can enjoy the flavor of Russian cultural life and also it is the best place to buy souvenirs. You will walk through Zamoskvorechye as well. Moscow metro is one of the most beautiful and one of the largest in the world. Each day more than 7 bln. passengers pass through its doors. During the excursion you will see its most beautiful stations, built in the 1930-1950ss and learn a lot of curious facts about history of Moscow Metro and its present. Each of the stations is like an art gallery where you can make wonderful pictures. You will discover why Moscow subway is recognized as the most beautiful in the world! "They used to have palaces for kings, we are going to build palaces for people!" - said one of the main architects of the Soviet subway. Our guide will tell fascinating stories and secrets hidden underground.
